

Proposed charter moving forward

NAMPA — Founding board members of Nampa Classical Academy updated Nampa School Board members on the school's progress during the district's board meeting Tuesday night.

The new charter school would provide a classical education for children who live within the Nampa School District boundaries.

Academy Chairman Michael Moffett told the Nampa School Board that the proposed charter has already filed for non-profit status and filed a petition for sufficiency review with the state. Next, it must present a charter petition to the Nampa School District, although it isn't clear when that will occur.

Nampa Classical Academy founders have met twice with district officials and have also had two public meetings to gather support from parents of potential students. The school has also gathered 28 of the 30 necessary signatures from Nampa district residents who say they think the school should be allowed to form.
